For years GIS positions and titles have been created with job requirements specific to the organization creating the positions. A GIS Analyst in one agency would have different tasks and duties than a GIS Analyst in another agency. A GIS Specialist position may be higher or lower than a GIS Analyst position. Skills and knowledge of GIS vary from job to job. That may be changing.

In July of this year the US Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration announced the release of an industry competency model for geospatial technology. Competency models are resources for curriculum development and evaluation, recruitment and hiring, certification and assessment development, career guidance and apprenticeship program development.
